DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

Section 1

1. Enter the billing account information in Section 1, the Account Holder **MUST** be an adult.
 - a. For individual passes, the adult does not need to be a member
 - b. For family passes, the adult **MUST** be a member
2. Decide which membership type you are obtaining: Individual or Family
 - a. Individual memberships are for one member (two individuals can be put on one form)
 - b. Family is for more than three members. A family should consist of at least one parent and their children (See "Membership Guidelines" for additional details)
3. If you are applying for a Family Membership, you may only have **SIX** card holders on a membership
4. Verify your residency (Upper Leacock Township, East Lampeter Township, West Earl Township, or others outside of these Townships) (Your residency is where you pay your municipal taxes.)

Section 2

5. Fill in the names, birthdates, and ages of anyone wanting a pass
6. A birth date is **NEEDED** with the computer system

Section 3

7. Add any additional cardholders to the account. Remember, there is a maximum of **SIX** cardholders per family
8. Total up the number of members in Sections 2 and 3, #7 who are between the ages of 4 and 64
9. Complete the math for the Individual or Family Membership plan
10. Deduct the discount **IF** you submit your membership application **BEFORE** May 14, 2010
11. Sign the membership form

YMCA/LEOLA COMMUNITY POOL RULES

1. No swimming when lifeguard is not on duty.
2. All swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
3. Obey lifeguards at all times. Do not distract the lifeguard.
4. Food, gum, or drinks are not permitted on the pool deck.
5. Smoking is not permitted on pool property.
6. **NO** pushing, shoving, tripping or other dangerous behavior.
7. **NO** profanity, excessive noise or indecent behavior.
8. Proper bathing attire must be worn at all times. **NO** tee shirts, jean or gym shorts. Infants must have water proof diapers.
9. A person with any type of open wound that is not properly bandaged will not be allowed in the pool. Lifeguard must approve all such instances.
10. Please refrain from sunbathing or sitting on the pool decks.
11. Children under the age of **10** must pass a swim test to stay at the pool without adult supervision, use the slides and be in the deep sections of the pool.
12. Parents must supervise young children at all times.
13. Floatation devices must be Type 2 Coast Guard Approved. **No swimmies.** Non swimmers must stay within arm's length of their guardian at all times, and remain in the shallow end of the pool. For safety reasons, **NO** tubes, noodles or rafts are permitted in the pool. Infant rafts are permitted with a parent.
14. The East Pool (lap pool) is for lap swimming, water jogging and YMCA program use **ONLY**. The lap pool may be used for recreational swimming during times of extreme crowds, which will be determined by the Manager on duty.
15. Circle swim etiquette will be used when there are more than two (2) swimmers in a lane.
16. Soft sponge balls are permitted. All other pool toys must be approved by the lifeguard.
17. Goggles are permitted, with the exception of those with sharp or protruding parts.
18. Swim fins are only permitted for lap swimming.
19. **NO** glass containers of any kind inside the pool area.
20. **NO** diving in **ANY** pool, unless under the supervision of a coach or swim instructor. Starting blocks are to be used only under the supervision of a coach. Please enter the water feet first **AT ALL TIMES**.
21. Please obey the posted rules for the slides. **NO HEAD FIRST ENTRIES.**
22. Report any accidents or concerns immediately to the lifeguard or manager on duty.

VIOLATION OF RULES COULD RESULT IN:

Warnings, suspension or ejection from the premises, loss of attendance rights or prosecution.

Membership Guidelines

1. A **Family Membership** is limited to use by members of the account holder's immediate family.
2. **Immediate Family** is defined in relation to an individual (account holder) as:
 - a. his or her spouse,
 - b. child (natural and adoptive) under the age of 18 living in the same household,
 - c. children who are full-time students over the age of 18 living in the same household, and
 - d. dependent parent(s) living in the same household.Other members of the household not related by blood or marriage are not considered as members of the immediate family unless covered below.
3. **Non-adoptive children** of previous marriages who are to be included in "immediate family" may be required to obtain a letter from their school or supply a birth certificate to prove parentage. Such proof of identification will be filed with the application and will be effective until the child turns 18.
4. **Grandchildren** who are living with the individual for the summer may be included in the family season pass at the regular rates.
5. **Foreign Exchange Students and Fresh Air Children** can be included in the family membership at the regular rates.
6. A **Nanny**, or caretaker other than the parent, may be included with the family season pass at the regular rates.
7. **Other Relatives** living with family (e.g. – brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, etc.) must purchase their own season pass.
8. Passes are **Non Transferable** and **Non Refundable** and may be **revoked by management**. Unauthorized use results in automatic loss of membership.
9. If under 10, the child **MUST** pass a swim test or he/she will not be admitted without proper supervision.
10. If child is 3 or under or an adult is 65 and over, they do not need to pay for a membership or admission fee. The child should be listed on the application for future reference.
11. Fee for replacing lost passes is \$3.00/each.
12. All pool customers are required to obey the rules and instructions of the lifeguards and staff.
13. Applications received by May 14th 2010 will be given a \$10.00 discount.
14. The Pool Management shall determine early closing due to attendance or weather conditions.
15. Pre-paid pool membership passes will be available at the pool starting on opening day.
