Public Supervisors Vote 'Yes' for Lancaster Family YMCA to Manage Pool
Upper Leacock Township Pool to be managed by non-profit organization

Upper Leacock Township, PA – One year ago, Upper Leacock Township asked the Lancaster Family YMCA Association to consider managing their outdoor pool at 23 East Main Street, Leola. This evening, February 19, 2009, at the ULT Public Supervisor's meeting, the vote confirmed that the YMCA Association would take over the pool's management.

The concept of the partnership between the ULT pool and the Lancaster Family YMCA was planned to help relieve the township of the burden of operating the pool by transitioning it's management to the YMCA. The partnership arrangement allows the Lancaster Family YMCA Association to manage, supervise, and deliver programs for the ULT outdoor pool, including expert life guard staff and swim lessons.

The Lancaster Family YMCA successfully manages their current facility at 572 N. Queen Street, Lancaster, and is preparing to open a new branch in Lampeter-Strasburg's Village Park in May 2009, as well as a new City Center at 265 W. Harrisburg Avenue in downtown Lancaster in September 2009.

According to Upper Leacock Township resident and YMCA Swim Team parent Jennifer Kurisky, "The YMCA coaches provide a loving and positive environment for the swimmers and their families. I am thrilled to see them take over the management of the Upper Leacock Pool! Their commitment to their jobs as coaches and mentors is truly inspiring. I can only imagine that the atmosphere at the pool will be much more positive under their guidance and management."

As a non-profit organization, all the YMCA's programs benefit the entire community through membership services and financial assistance. One example of how the YMCA benefits local communities financially is the YMCA's after-school child care in the Solanco and New Holland School Districts. Under the Y's management, the school district does not carry this cost.

The Lancaster Family YMCA Association looks forward to building relationships in Upper Leacock Township. The YMCA is led by community volunteers and will continue that charitable heritage by hosting a community-based advisory group to assist in managing the operations. Meeting community needs is the YMCA's top priority, and by involving community members, those needs will be more easily identified.

Outdoor pool employment is seasonal and ends at the conclusion of each season. According to Lancaster Family YMCA Executive Director Janet Nelson, "The ULT pool is sure to deliver on the promise of meeting community needs. We are looking forward to a strong swim season!"

Guests are always welcomed at our pool and we are open to the general public. Daily visitor rate is \$8.00 for ages 4 to 64. \$5.00 after 5:00 p.m.

All season memberships must be obtained at the Township Office, 36 Hillcrest Avenue, Leola; Township hours are 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Membership paperwork will no longer be processed at the pool. Pre-paid pool passes can be picked up at the pool on the first day you attend.

DIRECTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

Section 1

1. Enter the billing account information in Section 1, the Account Holder **MUST** be an adult.
 - a. For individual passes, the adult does not need to be a member
 - b. For family passes, the adult **MUST** be a member
2. Decide which membership type you are obtaining: Individual or Family
 - a. Individual memberships are for one or two members
 - b. Family is for more than three members. A family should consist of at least one parent and their children (See "Membership Guidelines" for additional details)
3. If you are applying for a Family Membership, you may only have SIX card holders on a membership
4. Verify your residency (Upper Leacock Township, East Lampeter Township, West Earl Township, or others outside of these Townships) (Your residency is where you pay your municipal taxes.)

Section 2

5. Fill in the names, birthdates, and ages of anyone wanting a pass
6. A birth date is **NEEDED** with the computer system

Section 3

7. Add any additional cardholders to the account. Remember, there is a maximum of SIX cardholders per family (with a few exceptions)

Section 4

8. Total up the number of members in Sections 2 and 3 who are between the ages of 4 and 64
9. Complete the math for the Individual or Family Membership plan
10. Deduct the discount IF you submit your membership application **BEFORE** May 15, 2009
11. Sign the membership form

POOL RULES – LEOLA COMMUNITY POOL

1. For your safety, always obey our lifeguards and pool staff.
2. **DO NOT** distract the lifeguards while they are on duty.
3. Food, gum, drinks and smoking are not permitted on the pool deck.
4. **NO** pushing, shoving, tripping or other dangerous behavior.
5. **NO** profanity, excessive noise, or indecent behavior.
6. **Eyewear** worn in the pool is under the discretion of the lifeguard.
7. Proper bathing attire must be worn at all times; infants must have waterproof diapers.
8. A person with any type of open wound that is not properly bandaged will not be allowed in the pool. Lifeguard must approve all such instances.
9. Please refrain from sunbathing or sitting on the pool decks.
10. Children under the age of **10** must pass a swim test to stay at the pool without adult supervision.
11. Parents must supervise young children at all times.
12. Non swimming children may wear Coast Guard approved floatation devices (life jackets) in the pool, however they must stay within arm's length of their guardian at all times, and remain in the shallow end of the pool. For safety reasons, **NO** tubes, noodles, or rafts are permitted in the pool.
13. The East Pool (lap pool) is primarily a "No Splash" pool. The "No Splash" may be lifted during times of extreme crowds. Children will generally **NOT** be permitted in the pool unless they are completing a workout or they are infants being held by a parent.
14. Soft sponge balls are permitted
15. Goggles are permitted, with the exception of those with sharp or protruding parts.
16. Swim fins are only permitted for lap swimming.
17. **NO** glass containers of any kind inside the pool area.
18. **NO** diving in **ANY** pool unless under the supervision of a coach or swim instructor. Please enter the water feet first **AT ALL TIMES**.
19. Please obey the posted rules for the slides. **NO HEAD FIRST ENTRIES**.
20. Report any accidents or concerns immediately to a lifeguard or manager on duty.

VIOLATIONS OF RULES CAN RESULT IN:

Warnings, suspensions or ejection from premises; loss of attendance rights or prosecution.

Membership Guidelines

1. A **Family Membership** is limited to use by members of the account holder's immediate family.
2. **Immediate Family** is defined in relation to an individual (account holder) as:
 - a. his or her spouse,
 - b. child (natural and adoptive) under the age of 18 living in the same household,
 - c. children who are full-time students over the age of 18 living in the same household, and
 - d. dependent parent(s) living in the same household.Other members of the household not related by blood or marriage are not considered as members of the immediate family unless covered below.
3. **Non-adoptive children** of previous marriages who are to be included in "immediate family" may be required to obtain a letter from their school or supply a birth certificate to prove parentage. Such proof of identification will be filed with the application and will be effective until the child turns 18.
4. **Grandchildren** who are living with the individual for the summer may be included in the family season pass at the regular rates.
5. **Foreign Exchange Students and Fresh Air Children** can be included in the family membership at the regular rates.
6. A **Nanny**, or caretaker other than the parent, may be included with the family season pass at the regular rates.
7. **Other Relatives** living with family (e.g. – brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, etc.) must purchase their own season pass.
8. Passes are **Non Transferable and Non Refundable** and may be **revoked by management**. Unauthorized use results in automatic loss of membership.
9. If under 10, the child **MUST** pass a swim test or he/she will not be admitted without proper supervision.
10. If child is 3 or under or an adult is 65 and over, they do not need to pay for a membership or admission fee. The child should be listed on the application for future reference.
11. Fee for replacing lost passes is \$3.00/each.
12. All pool customers are required to obey the rules and instructions of the lifeguards and staff.
13. Applications received by May 15th 2009 will be given a \$10.00 discount.
14. The Pool Management shall determine early closing due to attendance or weather conditions.
15. Pre-paid pool membership passes will be available at the pool starting on opening day.
