

Membership Guidelines

1. A **Family Membership** is limited to use by members of the account holder's immediate family.
2. **Immediate Family** is defined in relation to an individual (account holder) as:
 - a. his or her spouse,
 - b. child (natural and adoptive) under the age of 18 living in the same household,
 - c. children who are full-time students over the age of 18 living in the same household, and
 - d. dependent parent(s) living in the same household.Other members of the household not related by blood or marriage are not considered as members of the immediate family unless covered below.
3. **Non-adoptive children** of previous marriages who are to be included in "immediate family" may be required to obtain a letter from their school or supply a birth certificate to prove parentage. Such proof of identification will be filed with the application and will be effective until the child turns 18.
4. **Grandchildren** who are living with the individual for the summer may be included in the family season pass at the regular rates.
5. **Foreign Exchange Students and Fresh Air Children** can be included in the family membership at the regular rates.
6. **A Nanny**, or caretaker other than the parent, may be included with the family season pass at the regular rates.
7. **Other relatives** living with family (e.g. – brothers, sisters, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, etc.) must purchase their own season pass.
8. **Season passes are non-transferable.** Unauthorized use results in automatic loss of membership.
9. Passes are **Non Transferable** and **Non Refundable** and **may be revoked by management.**
10. If under 10, the child **MUST** pass a swim test or he/she will not be admitted without proper supervision.
11. If a child is 3 or under or an adult 65 or over, they do not need to pay for a membership or admission fee.
12. Fee for replacing lost passes is **\$3.00/each.**
13. All pool customers are required to obey the rules and instructions of the lifeguards and staff.
14. Applications received by May 19, 2008 will be given a \$10.00 discount per household account.
15. The Pool Management shall determine early closing due to attendance or weather conditions.
16. Pre-paid pool passes will be available at the pool starting on opening day.

Directions for completing the membership application

Section 1

1. Update the billing account information in Section 1, the Account Holder **MUST** be an adult.
 - a. for individual passes, the adult does not need to be a member,
 - b. for family passes, the adult **MUST** be a member.
2. The account holder **MUST** provide us with a PA Driver's License and **MUST** present the ID when picking up the passes. (When picking up passes, another adult in the family may provide their ID to claim passes.) **PASSES WILL NOT BE MAILED OUT IN ADVANCE OF OPENING DAY!**
 - a. If the account holder does not have a PA Driver's License, a utility bill may be used in its place.
3. Decide which membership type you are obtaining: Individual or Family
 - a. Individual memberships are for one or two members,
 - b. Family is for more than three to five. A family should consist of at least one parent and their children (See "Membership Guidelines" for additional details).
4. **NEW 2008:** If you are applying for a Family Membership, you may only have SIX card holders on a membership
5. Verify your residency (Conestoga Valley School District comprises East Lampeter and West Earl Townships)
 - a. Your residency is where you pay your municipal taxes.

6. Cross out any cardholder who will not be getting a pass this year.
7. A Date of Birth is **NEEDED** with the computer system and going forward will update with each pool season for age categories, i.e. minor, under 4, 65 and over, 10 and under, etc.

Section 3

8. Add any additional cardholders to the account. Remember, there is a max. of SIX cardholders.

Section 4

9. Total up the number of members in Sections 2 and 3 who are between the ages of 4 to 64.
10. Complete the math for the Individual or Family Membership plan.
11. Deduct the discount **IF** you submit your membership application **BEFORE** May 19th.
12. Sign the membership form.

Pool Rules

1. ALWAYS obey our lifeguards and managers.
2. DO NOT distract the lifeguards while they are on duty.
3. While on the deck, **DO NOT: RUN, EAT, or SMOKE**
4. NO pushing, shoving, tripping or other dangerous behavior.
5. NO profanity, excessive noise, or indecent behavior.
6. NO eye glasses or sunglasses permitted in the pool.
7. NO sunbathing or sitting on the deck areas.
8. Children under the age of 10 must pass a swim test to stay at the pool without adult supervision.
9. All non-toilet-trained children must wear tight fitting "Little Swimmer" diapers.
10. Parents must supervise all young children at all times.
11. Children with flotation devices must be attended in the water at all times within one arm's length and may only be in the shallow end of the West Pool. All floatation devices must be USCG approved.
12. NO flotation tubes, rafts, toys, etc. are permitted in the pool.
13. The East Pool is primarily a "No Splash" pool. The "No Splash" may be lifted during times of extreme crowds. Children will generally not be permitted in this pool unless they are completing a work out or they are infants being held by the parent.
14. Soft sponge balls are permitted. Exception: balls determined to be dangerous.
15. Goggles are permitted. Exception: any goggles with sharp or protruding parts.
16. NO swim fins permitted in main pool. May use for lap swimming in lap pool only.
17. NO glass containers of any kind inside the pool area.
18. NO diving in any pool. Enter the water feet first in ALL POOLS.
19. Always obey the posted rules for the slides.
20. Report accidents or concerns to a lifeguard or to the manger.

VIOLATIONS OF RULES CAN RESULT IN:

Warnings, suspensions or ejection from the premises, loss of attendance rights or prosecution.

Park Rules

1. The two large pavilions are by **RENTAL ONLY**. Reservations can be made with the Pool Manager or the Township Office (Pre-Season). Available rental time is from 10:00 AM to 7:30 PM.
2. The baseball/softball field is by RESERVATION. If the field is not being used, it is on a first come basis. Reservations can be made with the Pool Manager. The playing field may **NOT** be altered in any way.
3. Tennis Courts, Basketball Courts and the Beach Volleyball as well as the small sun shelters are first come first serve.
4. All individuals and groups are required to clean up after themselves; trash receptacles are located throughout the grounds.
